His Eminence Yangsi Gyana Ta Rinpoche, the reincarnation of Thinley Norbu Rinpoche, was received with great warmth by a joyful assembly as he arrived at Pema Osel Ling Oct. 1.

At the edge of the center's offering pond, dancing snow lions, attendants and traditional music greeted Rinpoche with colorful fanfare as he walked a silky, maroon path leading to the Shrine Room.

For the Pema Osel Ling community, it was the return of our Wisdom Lama nearly 13 years after the parinirvana of Thinley Norbu Rinpoche without interruption of blessings from the lineage.

H.E. Yangsi Gyana Ta Rinpoche, now 12 years old, was shown all of Pema Osel Ling, including Drub Nyiy Döjö Gatsal Three-Year Retreat area and the Joyful Lotus Stupa

"We believe a teacher's incarnation is continuous, like this lineage is continuous," said Lama Sonam Tsering Rinpoche. "Rinpoche's physical presence is new, but feels already continuous with Thinley Norbu Rinpoche's activity. That's why Pema Osel Ling is truly fortunate to have an incarnation."





Ngondro Retreat March 30 - April 7, 2024

We welcomed back Sam Bercholz for the annual Dudjom Tersar Ngondro Retreat. Sam, who was authorized by Dungse Thinley Norbu Rinpoche to teach from Rinpoche's masterpiece "Cascading Waterfall of Nectar", taught this profound text with warmth and insight.

In Sam's words, "Buddhism teaches that enlightenment is our natural state. The problem is that we don't recognize this state, owing to the mind's confusion about its true nature." During the weekend, Sam shared his personal experiences and insights, inspiring us and helping us connect more deeply with the Ngondro practice.

The following week of retreat offered daily teachings and question-and answer sessions led by Tulku Thadral Rinpoche, Lama Sonam Rinpoche (with translations by Cy Kassoff), Amy Green and Drubpon Pema Rigdzin. Choying Wangmo and Stefan Graves, offered twice daily accumulation sessions. As in previous years, the retreat was held onsite and livestreamed on YouTube.

People attending the retreat commented on how inspiring it was being at Pema Osel Ling in person, in community with Sangha, practicing in front of the Guru



Rinpoche statue, and with so much personal contact and time spent with the Lama's and teachers.

Tulku Thadral Rinpoche bestowed a Dudjom Lingpa Vajrayogini Empowerment and a Refuge Ceremony complete with hair cutting and naming. This was followed by a Bodhisattva Vow Ceremony, and the reading Oral Transmission of the Dudjom Tersar Ngondro and Dudjom Troma Ngondro texts.

Earth Day Riwo Sang Chö Teaching and Puja at the Beach April 20, 2024

HH Dudjom Rinpoche said, "Riwo Sang Chö is a powerful practice for benefiting both the living and the deceased. In this practice, we make offerings to everyone with whom we have a karmic connection and repair damage caused over many lives. This removes obstacles to health and life force and creates auspicious circumstances for enlightenment.

Following the teaching Tulku Jamyang Rinpoche led a Riwo Sang Chö puja at Platforms State Beach. Since the 2024 Earth Day theme was "Planet vs. Plastics", we spent time picking up plastics and other trash on the beach.

Tseyang Khatrod Retreat May 14 - 18

Our Annual Summer Retreat started on May 14th with the combined empowerments for The Heart-Essence of the Lake-Born Vajra and Orgyen Khandro Norlha, with Tulku Thadral Rinpoche. The following days we received Oral Transmissions and practiced Tsokye T'huk T'hik (The Heart-Essence of the Lake-Born Vajra) and Orgyen Khandro Norlha. These practices together are called Tseyang Khatrod, a uniquely uplifting combination of long-life and wealth-gathering practices. Khandro T'huk T'hik Dakini Mendrup Drupchen May 21 - 30

Namgay Dawa Rinpoche presided over the Mendrup Drupchen as Dorje Lopon. Tulku Thadral Rinpoche gave the Yeshe Tsogyal Khandro T'huk T'hik empowerment and lungs.

Drupchen (Great Accomplishment) is an elaborate ritual practiced as a group, which draws on the full array of the skillful means of Vajrayana practice, such as the creation of the mandala, group sadhana practice, tsok offerings, continuous mantra recitation, ritual music, mudra, fire pujas, and sacred dance.

This year's Drupchen was special for several reasons.

- This was the 120th anniversary of Dudjom Rinpoche's birth, an especially auspicious time.
- We focused on Kyabje Dudjom Rinpoche's Dakini practice of Khandro T'huk T'hik, using a sadhana and jinsek (fire puja)

manual newly translated at Pema Osel Ling.

• This was also a Mendrup Drupchen, where special sacred substances are gathered, prepared and consecrated through intensive group practice.

A means toward ultimate liberation, mendrup practice increases meditative experience and realization and offers protection from outer, inner and secret obstacles.





Troma Nagmo Retreat June 1 - 5, 2024

This year our Troma Retreat focused on the Troma Ngondro and Four Feasts, with Sadhana practice. Tulku Thadral Rinpoche gave the Troma empowerment and the *lungs* for the Troma Ngondro, Four Feasts, Concise and Medium-Length Sadhanas. Rinpoche gave teachings and led everyone in practice.

Each evening we did the Concise Troma Sadhana with tsok using melodies, visualizations, and offerings as a method for healing the ailments of the body, speech, and mind with great compassion.

Tulku Thadral Rinpoche gave the empowerment for the *Dudjom Rituals and Prayers of the Shitro Cycle*. Kyabje Dudjom Rinpoche compiled our 100 Peaceful and Wrathful Deity practice, based on a Karma Lingpa treasure, as a method for practitioners to achieve fully enlightened Buddhahood by removing obstacles to the path, through restoring all broken precepts, vows and tantric samayas.

We included a Neydren ceremony again this year to benefit loved ones and all beings who have passed. Sangha members sent in the names of their loved ones and the names were burned on the last day of the ceremony.

Collection of Seven Treasures Guru Rinpoche Retreat June 10 - 16





Preparing for the Sacred Black Hat

This year our retreat included The Collection of Seven Treasures as a puja and practice without the usual Drupchen, which was included earlier in the summer as a Dakini Mendrup Drupchen. This "most supreme among all Lama Accomplishment (Ladrup) practices was compiled by His Holiness Dudjom Rinpoche from seven great treasures of the Nyingma Lineage. Lama Sonam Rinpoche says that "He compiled them all into one simple practice.... through which we can actually accomplish enlightenment in a single lifetime."

We performed the traditional sacred dances that correspond to the sections of the sadhana ritual, as well as the Eight Manifestations.

Children's Retreat June 11 - 15, 2024



We had six returning children participate in our Children's Retreat this summer. Sangha members Erin and Sidra led the program with the assistance of several parents and other volunteers.

Once again, our youth are learning about "Thinking good things, saying good things and doing good things" while their parents attend Drupchen in the shrine room. The lamas took turns talking to the children about the Dharma, loving kindness, and compassion for all living things. Children took nature walks, learned Tibetan language, offered tsok, learned about Ngondro prayers, made Dharma-oriented craft projects and tormas.

Lama Tharchin Rinpoche's Dechö July 21, 2024



This year marked the 11th anniversary of the parinirvana of our founder and most kind teacher, Lama Tharchin Rinpoche. We offered tsok and butter lamps with the Dorsem Lama Chopa puja, and lotus lights on Rinpoche's Ku-Dung Stupa. The lamas and sangha members enjoyed lunch on the meadow by Rinpoche's Stupa.



Resting in the Nature of Mind Teachings and *Lung* with Tulku Thadral Rinpoche October 25 - 27, 2024

Tulku Thadral Rinpoche gave the third teaching in a series based on *The Excellent Path to Enlightenment*, Longchenpa's practice manual based on *Finding Rest in the Nature of Mind (Sem Nyi Ngal So)*. This text covers the whole path of Dharma: the Four Thoughts, Ngondro, the Sutras, Outer and Inner Tantras; all nine levels of the path put together in one teaching. The entire work is a comprehensive guide to practicing Buddhism.

Dzongsar Jamyang Khyentse Rinpoche commented about this text, "Rest is what we all lack most. Even more agonizing is that we don't know how to do it; in fact, we don't even understand what it means to rest."

Thanksgiving Weekend Tara Retreat with Tulku Thadral Rinpoche November 29 - December 1, 2024

Tulku Thadral Rinpoche gave a beautiful Tara empowerment with the oral transmission for the practice of multiple Tara practices. He gave a special teaching on the Five Element Taras, which were crafted from marble and installed in our shrine room in 2023.

According to Lama Sonam Rinpoche, "On one of his visits to Pema Osel Ling, Our Lord of Refuge Dungse Thinley Norbu Rinpoche shared a prophecy with Lama Tharchin Rinpoche and me. He said that at the right time, statues of Four Elements Dakinis should be installed in our shrine room, to protect not only Pema Osel Ling, but the whole world.

"Tara offers the most powerful and universal protection from all negativity. The Four Element Taras, corresponding with fire, water, earth and air, specifically offer protection from disharmony of the elements that results in wildfires, earthquakes, hurricanes and floods. In Dudjom Lingpa's Green Tara practice, the fifth Tara (Green Tara) is included, offering protection from all obstacles, relief from the Eight Great Fears and support for harmony in the sangha and among all suffering beings."

Vajra Armor Retreat December 2 - 4

Vajra Armor is a practice favored by Tibetan physicians, and is said to have the power to cure all 404 types of disease. It is highly recommended for those facing health challenges. We offered this retreat again in 2024, with teachings and personal instruction for participants both in person and by streaming. Participants also had the opportunity to extend their retreat time for up to one month for personal practice.

Lama Tharchin Rinpoche's Recorded Teaching Archive Complete

We are very excited to announce that the project to transform our extensive catalog of Lama Tharchin Rinpoche's analog recorded teachings into modern digital formats has been completed!

Our collection includes cassette tapes, digital audio tapes and CDs, and video tapes. The result is nearly 5 terabytes of Rinpoche's wisdom contained in over 6,700 files.

The Lama Tharchin Rinpoche Heritage Foundation (LTRHF) carried out the effort, digitizing the audio resources in-house and converting everything to MP3 digital format. They hired outside, professional contractors to digitize our

video tapes. These have been preserved in MP4 formatted files. All the files have been named using a standard naming convention that includes the date of the resource, the teacher and a short title describing the content of the recording. These files are in folders also generally named for the content of the recordings. LTRHF has backed up all of this on four different geographically located servers in order to keep them protected.



We will be working with the LTRHF to make these recordings accessible to everyone.

Our heartfelt thanks go out to Eric Colombel, Libby Luning and the Lama Tharchin Rinpoche Heritage Foundation, as well as all the Vajrayana Foundation staff members, for fulfilling this wish of Lama Tharchin Rinpoche and Lama Sonam Rinpoche.

Joyful Lotus Stupa Mandala




Remarkably powerful site radiates positive energy

During 2024, our stupa project manager, John Reynolds, worked tirelessly with contractors, staff and volunteers, and the Joyful Lotus Stupa Mandala is really coming along beautifully. The area is remarkably powerful and radiates positive energy that is so needed in our world today.

The intricately patterned tile work in the courtyard is complete now, as are the pavers covering the korwa path around the exterior of the red auspicious fence. The marble columns of the fence and a nearby retaining wall support 152 small stupas.

We were able to get all the small stupas installed and the entryway concrete poured before Dungse Thinley Norbu Rinpoche's Yangsi, Gyana Ta Rinpoche's visit in early October. Everyone coming down to visit the stupas was so amazed and happy!



We are very close to finishing this project. One of the most important pieces remaining is the entry gate that Lama Sonam Rinpoche wants built at the entrance to the Stupa Mandala. In the West, Tibetan stupas hold a deep cultural and spiritual significance, symbolizing peace, compassion, and universal harmony. Lama Sonam Rinpoche tells us: "Stupas are very, very special. They represent Buddha's body, speech, and mind. Mainly they represent Buddha's mind, which is dharmakaya, or our own Nature of Mind. That's why connecting with this stupa is liberating; we will soon realize our own Buddha Nature, our Buddha Nature will blossom. Like that, it has an incomparable benefit."

Siddhi Dung Nyen One Hundred Million Mantra Recitations Activity

It is with great joy that we announce that in our great collective effort, we have recited over 100 million Vajra Guru and Pema Throtengtsal mantras! This is a cause for gratitude and rejoicing!

The drive to recite these 100 million mantras began in 2020, during the pandemic, when Lama Sonam Rinpoche made their recitation part of the Seven Treasures Drubchöd in Summer Retreat, when the land was closed.

"These mantras will help to pacify problems for all of us as individuals and the world in general, serve as a dedication of merit for the deceased and a long-life practice for the living, help to pacify difficulties, material hardships, and obstacles, and help to alleviate all of the suffering in the entire world, especially the suffering of epidemic diseases like we are experiencing now," Lama Sonam Rinpoche

When Tulku Thadral Rinpoche was recently informed that the goal had been met, he suggested that the Sangha continue by reciting **another 100 million mantras** for the benefit of the world.

You may accumulate one or both, as you feel comfortable.

Guru Rinpoche on the benefits of the Vajra Guru mantra:

"This is the essence mantra of all Sugatas, the accomplishment practice of all Victorious Buddhas in one."

"This will awaken you from clinging to the solidity of appearing existence. It is the condensation of all the Victorious Buddhas of the three times. It is indivisible from all lamas. It subdues all elemental spirits and arrogant spirits. Dakinis and dharma protectors will gather like clouds. All the male and female dakas and dakinis be overjoyed and come to bestow supreme and common siddhis. If you do not receive signs of accomplishment, then I, Padmasambhava, have deceived sentient beings."



"Seeds of Connection" Weddings and Groups at Pema Osel Ling

We began to host weddings at Pema Osel Ling years ago with the blessing of Dungse Thinley Norbu Rinpoche, Lama Tharchin Rinpoche and Lama Sonam Rinpoche.

Dungse Rinpoche said that weddings at Pema Osel Ling would "create virtue in the world". Lama Tharchin Rinpoche said "To step on sacred ground is to be inexorably connected to Buddha dharma. What is sacred ground? It is a place where sublime statues and stupas exist and where enlightened beings have walked, taught and given empowerments." This Vajrayana belief holds true for all beings who step on sacred ground, with or without intention or knowledge of Buddhism. Lama Sonam Rinpoche said, "It is like planting a seed that one day, no matter how many lifetimes may pass, will bear fruit."

The weddings we host create merit for all involved – not only by the income they generate, but by connecting many people to Buddha Dharma. Dungse Rinpoche told Lama Sonam Rinpoche to privately bless each wedding feast as a tsok offering and dedicate the merit for the wedding couple, guests and the entire sangha.

There are many testimonials from guests about their unexpected profound experiences at Pema Osel Ling. We want to share one here (there will be others shared on our new website which will be launched in 2025).

On a Sunday morning, after a wedding, the bride's father told us about a profound experience he had during the weekend. He explained that one of his daughters had died four years ago and that it tore his entire family apart, as so often happens.

They were all at Pema Osel Ling for the wedding and together for the first time in years. Before the wedding, he walked alone to the stupa. He said he had no real knowledge of Buddhism, but felt a strong urge to pray, although he was not a religious person. He told us that he prayed that something would happen to heal his family and he began to cry. Later, at the reception, much to his surprise, his wife asked him to dance and whispered that they were the only two people who could really understand what they had gone through. He said that after that, the family talked and danced together and he felt a "dark heaviness lift".

He asked us many questions about the stupa, feeling that his experience there was the catalyst for this profound reconciliation, and told us he was going to explore Buddhism.



In addition to weddings, we host outside group events. One group that has returned for several years is POC (People of Color) Yoga which supports yoga in underserved communities. We also host Vox Mundi, a group of international musicians and singers, who use their music to heal with sound. Their leader, who has been hosting the retreat at Pema Osel Ling for over 20 years, says that Pema Osel Ling is her "home". The weddings and group events at Pema Osel Ling connect thousands of people to the sublime Buddha Dharma and support all of our activity. We are very grateful for our lamas' vision and guidance, our guests' generosity and for the tireless efforts of our staff who make these joyful events possible!

Ngondro Program Personal Guidance on the Path of Enlightenment



Throughout 2024, the Dudjom Ngondro Program continued to support and encourage Ngondro practitioners and those just curious about Ngondro, by offering open-to-the-public, free monthly Ngondro teachings. These teachings are done on site at Pema Osel Ling and livestreamed on YouTube. For the members of the Dudjom Ngondro Program, we continue to offer these monthly events: Concise Dudjom Tersar Ngondro and Dudjom Troma Ngondro Accumulation Sessions, Question and Answer Sessions with Tulku Thadral Rinpoche, an annual personal interview with a lama and the annual Dudjom Tersar Ngondro Retreat. In 2025 we will be adding a Troma Ngondro Retreat with teachings and accumulation sessions as part of our Vajrayana Foundation's Annual Summer Retreat.

We have expanded the Dudjom Ngondro Program to include the **Dudjom Troma Ngondro**. Beginning in October of 2023 through October of 2024, as part of the public monthly Ngondro teaching series, Tulku Thadral Rinpoche gave an eight-part, in-depth teaching of the Troma Nagmo Ngondro from the cycle of teachings of Traktung Dudjom Lingpa. In the final teaching of the series, Rinpoche gave the transmission blessing of the Ngondro with his unique melodies, while using drum, bell and kangling. This addition to the Ngondro Program provides the same rich support and benefits to Troma Ngondro practitioners. Interest continues to grow for the Troma Ngondro Program and we welcome any dedicated practitioner who sincerely wants to accomplish this practice to join.

We appreciate the support of Tulku Thadral Rinpoche, Lama Sonam Tsering Rinpoche and our kind staff and mentors. The Dudjom Ngondro Program is honored to be part of and to have helped create an environment for a worldwide sangha community who are dedicated and committed to dharma practice. Since 2023 our social media following has tripled, with our reach now extending from North America to Brazil, to Bhutan, to Europe and all points in between!

Facilities, Maintenance and Upgrades

Paving the Eastern Cabin Road

This year has been a whirlwind of facility activity at Pema Osel Ling, as we deal with our aging infrastructure. We've implemented plans to care for many of our buildings, from guest cabins to spaces that accommodate our precious teachers. We are overjoyed to report that Tulku Thadral Rinpoche's cabin renovation was finished this year. We were also able to upgrade our translator's cabin and are working on the cabin for our Three Year Retreat master Drubpon Pema Rigdzin. Thank you again to everyone who has helped with these vital projects.

Significant efforts were devoted to the Shrine Room. We covered the exterior wood paneling with fire resistant cement board, ensuring long-term protection.

Trees and bushes were cleared around the shrine for fire safety. Dedicated volunteers equipped with climbing gear worked under the hot summer sun scrubbing the shrine's roof. The Eastern Guest Cabin area saw a complete overhaul of the road and pathways, with erosion control and application of environmentally sustainable path materials, as well as extensive tree and brush removal. There were also improvements to the cabins' interior to make everyone's stay more comfortable.



A top priority has been improving our ponds, wells and water resources, which are vital for sustaining our activities and preparing for emergency situations such as road closures, power outages and wildfires. We bought 2 new water pumps, reopened an existing well and installed more water pipes.

To improve fire safety and drought resilience, we are constantly clearing brush around buildings and creating fire breaks throughout the property. We continue to replace flammable trees and plants near buildings with fire-safe and drought-resistant plants.

Dharma Treasures The Wish-Fulfilling Treasure House of Dharma



Dharma Treasures, "The Wish-Fulfilling Treasure House of Dharma," offers print and digital practice texts, ritual and shrine items, books, recordings of teachings, and unique Himalayan gifts.

Our store remodel in 2022 has helped us serve more customers during retreats and weddings, and given us precious storage space for our nearly-doubled inventory.

In September 2023 we migrated the online store to a new Shopify platform,

which has made our customer interface and backend management much better all around.

Nearly two-thirds of our business is now coming from online customers. Over the past year, the store's sales have grown significantly compared to the previous 12 months, with over 3100 orders fulfilled.

In addition to providing an important service to our Dharma customers, the store is now making a significant contribution to the financial well being of the Foundation.

Continuity of Three-Year Retreat In accord with the aspirations of Lama Tharchin Rinpoche in 1992, together with all our precious Lamas, the retreat activity has continued for over 30 years. It is our intention to continue Lama

Tharchin Rinpoche's aspirations by maintaining the facility, producing quality didactic material and inviting lamas to teach the retreatants, while providing spiritual guidance and care.

A new retreat began this year, with three retreatants. They underwent three months of training, accomplishing Ngondro and Three Roots practices, and gaining confidence to correctly perform a Vajrayana sādhanā – including torma making, chanting, playing instruments and chöpön activities. They also keep the land pristine, and are getting to know each other as they live communally.

Now six months into retreat, they are engaging in intensive practice for 12 hours a day, and embarking on the unique journey of the three inner yogas of the creation and completion phases, according to the Dudjom Tersar.

We want to express our gratitude to our lamas, staff and all who serve Drubdra selflessly with compassion, to Tsadra Foundation and all our sponsors, particularly those who bring stability by contributing monthly, and for all of you who keep Drubdra in your hearts!

Magical Display of the Arts

Tulku Thadral Rinpoche Constructing a Mandala

All retreats and Dharma activities at Pema Osel Ling rely on the skillful preparations of resident artists, who produce detailed ritual items for the ongoing ceremonies. Magical Display of the Arts (MDA), a team of resident and volunteer artists, is responsible for the production and careful arranging of the shrine mandala, retreat activities and ritual items. MDA supports two large retreats and multiple sadhanas and empowerments throughout the year, including Dechos, Dakini and Guru Rinpoche Day pujas and our own Tuesday Troma practice. In 2024, MDA supported two elaborate special events included a Mendrup Drupchen with Namgyal Dawa Rinpoche, and the visit of Gyana Ta Rinpoche with processions, long-life ceremony and sacred dance, along with two new Snow Lion costumes and their lion tamer!

Costumed sacred dancing (*Cham*), is a special part of our large retreats. We are one of few places in the West where this living tradition is practiced and available to learn. In 2024 we began offering online dance classes as well as teaching them on site during Summer Retreat.

All of our art activity is overseen by lamas who were traditionally trained by Dudjom Rinpoche. We are always training new students who express interest and aptitude.

In 2024, among many projects we:

- made the Portrait sculpture and palace for the long life ceremony of Yangsi Gyana Ta Rinpoche.
- made molds for stupa projects
- Resculpted, painted and gilded multiple sacred objects
- built a new large Lion Throne for Gyana-Ta Rinpoche
- built several palace mandalas
- made hundreds of tormas
- created a new set of molds for the base ornaments of the lion throne
- gilded the sun, moon and norbu at the top of the Parinirvana Stupa at the Joyful Lotus Stupa Mandala
- gilded the standing buddha plaque
- worked on new gilded throne back for Tulku Tadral Rinpoche

In addition, two special projects were undertaken by our resident lama, Tulku Thadral Rinpoche, two large-scale models in the Round House: one of Zangdolpari, and the other a Vajrakilaya mandala. Beautiful!

Our unique team of artisans was also in demand outside of Pema Osel Ling, with gilded sun /norbu in 24k gold and a moon in palladium shining brightly in the forest of Big Sur, California!
